

create cmds sql in an sp.txt

I have always been annoyed by the fact you can't issue DDL commands - i.e. CREATE and DROP - inside SPS. But fear not there is a way. You have to use dynamic SQL aka executesql.

DECLARE
    @MyQuery NVARCHAR(2000),
    @MyViewName VARCHAR(50)
BEGIN
    ...

    SET @MyQuery = N'CREATE VIEW dbo.vw_Transactions2 AS SELECT *
FROM Transactions WITH (nolock)'
    EXEC sp_executesql @MyQuery

    SET @MyQuery = N'DROP VIEW dbo.vw_Transactions2'
    EXEC sp_executesql @MyQuery

    SET @MyQuery = N'CREATE TABLE CLEANUP_temp(id INT)'
    EXEC sp_executesql @MyQuery

    SET @MyViewName = 'vw_TransXophe'
    SET @MyQuery = N'CREATE VIEW dbo.' + CONVERT(NVARCHAR,
@MyViewName) + N' AS SELECT * FROM Transactions WITH (nolock)'
    EXEC sp_executesql @MyQuery

    ...
END
